8th ANNIES B DAY 1866

side 10th June moved a little
windy ice not good 11th fine
froze some last night Put a
handle in my axe got some
fish Seander and Fernandez
crossed to the foot of Hamiltons
Island and got the Mail at Hamiltons
cutting up at the West Pease
12th on this Day of the Month 1866
my Mary departed
windy frosty cold

1867
James Cameron Island 30th January
Fine frosty W Wind thrashed oats
that was on the Pease began
the Pease. Put Bait down on
the ice cut some Nails up in the
West Pease 7 oars came last night
air-holes smoking Unfortunate Day
14th Unfortunate Day Fine clear
& frosty some foggy & Wind drew
a Load of Wood Bad with
Rheumatism Stratering nails
15th Fortunate Day Fine cold
Thrashing the Big Pease and oats
Seander crossed for the Mail got
a Letter from Bismarck B C
got an Almanac from D. M. M.
with compliments 16th June
Warm W Wind some grains of
snow moved our Bed put our
feet to the South for a change
my Good Dog Sport Dead
without me seeing Him
Peling some Wood cutting
stove wood Fernandez came had
new axe - him and Seander went to
see the Hockley game in Summerville
Randolph came
Canoeer Beat Randolph came
