

July 1792
Widow Anne & Elisabeth Nighswander
& Alfred Spragge & wife were here
at dinner. Anne & Elisabeth Nighswander
staid for supper. W. very warm
a Thunder shower before daylight
another went South West this evening

25 Finished cutting wheat A M took in
Bag of Sewail hay along Creek behind
Meeting house P M W. very warm
I went to Cedar Grove & to B^r D^r after
supper B worked at B^r D^r today he has
been there all last week except half day
& a heavy Thunder after dark heavy wind

26 drew 2 locals dist onto claim A M
boys set up shocks P M the wind blew
down a great snow last night

G & J & Henry Cut a 12 foot Cedar log
in the Shulok Swamp P M they
took it to I M then we harnessed
& rolled the new turnpike after supper
B^r N had a road machine last night
to grade from 11th Con to our bridge

27 Boys Cut & drew 2 logs A M A & Adeline
went to Markham A M Boys all went
to G Peppers Stock Sale on 9th Con Markham
P M, W. very warm, heavy Thunder shower P M

July 1792
28 Chovel & J H & Henry Cut & drew 2 logs
to I M A M B brought D Ramers Honey
extractors then boys sling about 50 lbs
of Honey P M the very very warm heavy
Thunder shower about 5 P M the
heaviest of it went South & east

I think this was the warmest day so far
29 Boys Peled lot of lumber at F^r's & J
Plowed F^r's lane to level it. (the lane that
goes to the bush) A M they had turnip P M
I took Gobbler & Basket of B^r Currants
to Lewis's farm this evening W. very warm
East of wind & equal of rain came up P M

30 I boys plowed in pasture field we are
thinking of fixing it for Fall wheat H
they put Paris Green on potatoes A M
I got more Bonin shod P M W. fine & cool

Dunday 31 I & Mary Henry & Anne went to
Meeting at Altona services by B^r C Sermon
on Malaka 12th C by C Burkholder went to
B^r in law John Horner to dinner & to Henry Boyers
to supper W. very fine summer day A Letter
many were in Meeting too

August 1st drew in all our Fall wheat till supper
then boys helped Flains draw in his de & Jess
helped us W. very fine summer day
