went off to Day took with Mr Mrs Donagalls Making
Mollasses Monkey Calved 15th Only Calved Sandy ^{found}
here with Mr Donagalls Bismarck at Mr Donagalls
with Harry at the Boat got a stick for an air
20th Made some Mollasses Cows to the Bush took
the Dishes from the Trees Sap running well
Made the ship at the House 21st Land Randolph
crossed to the mountains for my canoe John Bowling
in the Bush got 2 Bags of Potatoes Fine Day
22nd Loby and Lamine Calved Killed the only calf
23rd Randolph crossed with 3 Days of Eggs Bought
Sea Matches Thread set traps for Wild Geese 24th
Sunday High Wind Fine 25th St Marks Day 8 Wind
high Fine Planting Potatoes got a Photo
Bug a Propeller went up Lights lit up in
the Lower Lighthouses set 2 Hens to hatch
with 10 Duck Eggs Hen Eggs 14 Gordon Making
a Paddle 2 1/2th Morning putting out Manure 27th
a Foggy Morning 8th Wind St Francis first Trip up and
the first Trip for the Prince Louise Gordon and
I to Fort Covington a Deer skin Muskrat Cat skin
50 cents Got my Boots Fixed 45 cents Dinner 25th
Bought 1/2 Flour 1st 50 Tea 40 Tea 50 cents 2 lbs
Castor oil 10 Soap 9 cents Soda 8 cents pipe 1 cent
stop at Lukes had supper Water high snow
melting of the Mountains Mr Smith Poorly
called at Mayvilles wind bug & got lower
Fine Gordon and Randolph to fish
to night

Mr James Mr Dougall Willie and Alexander here had
Rory's new Boat took home the Sugar Bush
Kilgiving. Planted 4 Rows of Potatoes across took home
the Ashes and the Barrel and the Pot a Fine Day
23rd Fixing the Gate Rained some hailing beginning
around the Gate 30th Fine crossed to Hamillons
with Gordon sent Randolph to the Store
with 10 1/2 lbs of sugar at 9 cents Bought 1/2 Primer
1/2 yds of Calico shingles nails got 3 Bags of Potatoes
at Hamillons got a Letter and 2 Papers from
Charles Supper Liverpool England Workhouse
Walton on the Hill Squally Rain some snow
Grains a Good many Boats to Day 1st of May
Sunday Fine & Wind Rained some Boats John He
and I to the Surgeon Island In P.M. in the
Garden 2nd Day Mr Dougall here took home the
Driving Thrift a Peewee Went Down
Washing in the Garden 4th the Bohemian
up for the first Soup the Corn came up went
into Salmon River the Bohemian took
Fire in Cornwall throve the Cotton
Bags Overboard to save her Planting some
Mr Randolph and I to the Butternut Island
Rope Island that hit lots of Ducks Wild
Geese Plenty Seen Duck & Bewhove at
Charles Island getting their Surgeon Lines
Seen a Place on Ropes Island where there
was a Hole Dug last Summer all covered over
got a Trade of the 3 Boys on the Pit Point
supposed to be killed by the Fox killed a
Black Snake on Ropes Island 6th crossed to Mr Wards
Bought 1 Pair of Lace Boots 4th 10 Salt & 1/2 Fine
to my Account 4 7/8 lb of sugar at 10 cents 4th 10 cents
Randolph Bought clove and Saw I found a lot of
Cotton Bags that was thrown by the Bohemian
got 2 Bags of Potatoes at Hamillons
the Corn into Summer town
