P M we spread 4 loads manure No 2 turnip land. I buried ram that Wilhi found dead in No 4 bush. Mary was at Jamesons at Patriotic meeting came home before it was done for me to drive her down town before the stores closed. We went to the woods and bought a soft felt hat for myself and necktie or apr then we drove over to cemetery with some sods then along home got tea done then cut some more sods and took them to cemetery and nearly finished sodding the lot. Mrs & Miss Foley came in out of the shower about 6 P M.

Saturday

Fine day warmest yet. Mostly sunny, cloudy some. We finished manuring turnip land No 2 2nd time 6 1/2 loads then we cultivated it & the mangel land. I cultivated corn P M with corn cultivator, corn is just spring up. I drove down town at night Maud in buggy took Mary down to stay. I paid J. Beattie insurance \$10.32 tax 2 ds charge J.B. took 7 1/2 doz eggs to Simmons @ 35 ds 2.63 got oatmeal and pine apple 45 ds val \$2.18 on fr of goods got at Dulles sand paper 5 vanish 35 brought up hat & necktie from woods.

The constable put two boys in the cooler for fighting Mitchell & Ellis.
