 Sun 5 A very heavy snow storm all day
 Mon 6 The 80 I had a shock at an intertangent
 I drew in a stack of Hags a nice but cold day
 Tue 7 I went to Lonsdale to County Lodge a very cold day
 a very heavy snow and wind
- Wed 8 I took Uncle Robert and Uncle George out
 a terrible heavy rain all day
- Thu 9 we went from anet Sars out to Portland I saw
 Fri 10 We came home from out back to Lonsdale
- Sat 11 another very nice day. Horse trails at Lonsdale
 Sun 12 a very warm spring Lake day
 Mon 13 Uncle Robert went home to Lonsdale
