Willie took 1796 lbs oats cowdash to Wilsons after dinner then went down for them at 6 o'clock. I worked at crop chute. Mary down town in P.M. in cutter got from Mrs Oakes 42 cts butter Miss Gibson 60 cts butter paid Mrs Johns 50 cts stockings Russell \$2.00 boots for Father Phillips \$1.10 Delmester and Carbonic Acid Mennis lamp glass 8 cts <sup>20k</sup> sold to Armstrongs 11 lbs butter \$2.20 1 doz eggs 25- got goods 25 cts cash 1.00 balance 1.20 in c/c
