Saturday 13

Men finished hauling ice. Jack, Row, Jean and I went skating at rink and had a very nice time. Lovely mild night. Port Colborne defeated Paris 4-1 in sudden death game in Niagara Falls. Received two Valentines. Nice one from Jean.

Sunday 14

Received can of milk so didn't get home until five after twelve. Went up home in afternoon after Alex and I got bottles washed. Dad & Mother were away. Went down to see Jean after supper. Heard sermon on 'Ideal Wives' and Anna Case, wonderful soprano singer in Atwater Kent radio hour. nice time
