

July 27 Will & Arthur went to Helland
Paul cutting bushes on the roadside &
swept. I dusted the school house.
yesterday Arthur culivated our potatoe. The Reeb
beet was ruined it came out they went on the
hoe & came out & settled under the hoe.

Wed 28 Paul half day on the road got sick
Will had 7 o'cay to rake on the hill Mrs Reeb
came on the afternoon to say about the beet & at
night they came after them on the afternoon
another swarm came out & went on their hives
Traynor & Hallie went to pick berries made 10 lbs
instead of churning I washed out some things
in change my underwear

Thur 29 hot. I churned & packed a crock of
butter 11 1/2 lbs. Traynor went up in the evening to
George Hockmire to see if we could get seed potatoe
& could hardly churn it was such a heavy
churning

Fri 30 Traynor has gone over the river
made down with Tracy gig. I turned my
bed up & swept about 7 the chest took the
window out & washed it & put up a gleen
curtain & swepf & the dinner room traynor
brought our groceries home. Had 3 day 29 1/2 lbs
& 11 1/2 lbs butter @ 14. boxes 5th haldes 5 soap 10
ginger 10 tea 13 flour 25 Soda 6 castor oil 10 Lye 25
oat meal 25 Lemons 19 Stamps 2 sum 56

Sat 1 Dommerday July 1905 27
Dull all forenoon but 0 so hot. In the afternoon
it started to rain & at 7 p.m. rained the
poor little calves looked more dead than alive
I got wet through getting the turkeys home
rained on the night for all it was worth.
Arthur cut some hay Hallie stayed all night
& churned

Sun 2 weather don't look settled yet kept
the turkeys in the barn until noon the men
on mister prea sheet. Hallie & Tom help
here. In the afternoon I got out & everything
so quiet. ~~Will~~ Hallie came over in the afternoon
Traynor came home rode up with Mr Crookshank
From 3 dreadful hot - Paul went in & pick
strawberries made 7 1/2 lbs per basket. Churned
butter very soft Traynor working on Paul's
shirt - I scrubbed where there was hot carpet &
cleaned the floor & scrubbed all the boards
they drawed in to my pay

Mon 4. dreadful hot. I worked. The butter
then went at washing. I never felt the
heat so bad Roy. Carl & Clarence come
a terrible storm coming up wind blew
hard for while it looked as if we were
going to have a terrible bad storm my
heavy clop struck some where close from
at Chippawa but it rained so hard
