Willie took cream down in morning also shoe of pea puller or harrow got it lengthened at Hodge 20 cts on the spot 4 lbs stake at Hodge on the spot paid for Campbell for thrashing water R.R. got 25¢ Paid Chapman 10 cts for cup grease and manure spreader hinge which I put on pea harrow. We finished cutting peas to-day and cut some black oats in No 3 & badly down hard to cut. Norman Sandham up P.M. the family came Monday night from watering place. We skinned sheep that died yesterday hung it on ladder and John Willie brought F and M. up A.M. they walked down P.M. Wm Clark eggs 60 cts.

Fine sunny warm day. We cut sweet clover and finished cutting oats in No 3 & except what was too feet for binder then started in No 3 it is very badly down. P.M. we hauled in 6 loads ~~oats~~ peas. Norman up P.M. on his wheel.

## Friday

Very warm sunny day. We finished taking in the peas 1 1/2 loads more. P.M. we cut oats in No 3 with binder broke tongue got kind of Feds Norman up all day he raked sweet clover I could sort of it up. Jennie and family also came up P.M. and for tea. Mary gave Mr Barber 22 cts yesterday to pay postage on Eaton return parcel. Andrew Schram's over at night got 2 lambs weighed 93 & 100
