Fine warm sunny day: everybody starting
haymaking today. Willie cut some in 9:02 A.M.
in P.M. raked some up side delivery. looked
very much like thunder storm at night so we
couled some up. I scuffled turnips in A.M.
Lorne Ford finished thinning turnips in
A.M. and hove at potatoes 2 hours in P.M.
Jim Fernal up in A.M. thinned some
turnips and finished thinning carrots
I scuffled till 5 o'clock in P.M.
Girls went down at night in buggy
Got better money Mrs Wilson 160 no box 2. or potatoes
