## Surgical Items.

The old-fashioned method of using a bedroom pillow supplemented with strips of board on either side is still an excellent dressing, especially in fractures of the leg. Plaster-of-Paris dressings are difficult to properly adjust, and should never be used until one has acquired considerable skill in their application. In my opinion there are certain parts of the body where plaster-of-Paris should never be used except by surgical experts, that is, in fractures of the shaft of the humerus and femur, and in obscure injuries about the elbow and knee joints.—J. Alex. Hutchinson; Int. Journ. of Surg.
