Points on Anesthesia—No. 1.

Fully two days before an operation a purgative should be administered followed by a suitable diet the next day. This diet should be mainly liquid. Fruits, vegetables, and especially carbohydrates should be excluded. As milk causes a certain amount of residue in the intestines it should be limited. Much benefit is derived from intestinal antiseptics for a few days before. It is almost impossible to relax a patient when there is food in the stomach and distention with gas. Nausea and vomiting usually follow this condition.—Hunt; Int. Journ. of Surg.
