

At Grand Canyon Island 22<sup>nd</sup> May 1871  
 Washing the Wool a squally evening with wind  
 and Rain 23<sup>rd</sup> weighed of our own wool  
 what I was going to sell and what was  
 to be sent to be carded for stockings &  
 mits crossed to Sumnerston Walter  
 Baker put out to Day Bought of Andrew  
 on account of the Wool 2 lb 7s a 1/3<sup>rd</sup>  
 53 lb Flour 1 lb Butter and Plate  
 helping Walter to put his things in  
 Barbara Camerons Room 24<sup>th</sup> May  
 Birth Day fired a volley crossed to Col  
 Bakers with the Wool 2 lb 6 had  
 paid 25 cents and if he gets any more  
 he is to give it to me gave me 20 cents  
 a piece for 5 Rats paid him 2  
 Dollars for Norman Abrams got  
 Bought Rosewood Salt helping Walter  
 to move his things to Abrams house  
 George Parshaw took his wife and  
 all the family in the Boat with  
 a Roses andrew Harrowing Wheat  
 Went across with 2 Benshaw stop  
 all night to help him with the  
 scow 25<sup>th</sup> helping George taking the  
 scow out <sup>crossed an across</sup> seen Maxims daughter going to  
 Montreal and Catherine Donalds  
 Rae across to the Kenand high Wind 26  
 Digging a piece for corn at the old house  
 Went to Sumnerston Brought Mrs Spunk  
 Nutt nut cherry alder wife onions Brought  
 Thomas myroes Wool Ronald Angus and  
 Thomas a Bottle as I was starting away
