We washed buggy and in PM I drove girls over to Woods to E. Youngson's funeral. Willie and I went to funeral. Willie got off at home and got horses. I went to cemetery. Plowed some more after the funeral. May took 3 lbs butter to Armstrongs yesterday. Got groceries 4.66

Hail and snow last night ground all white cold day sunny. We took down the two cows sold to Shortreed May 1st. Got them down with drove that Jim Sanderson was taking down. I took wagon down with some straw which Willie took to J. Junes and brought up load manure to No 1. I sold two sheep skins C.P.R. accident over to J. Keenan \$2.00 The cows weighed crudem 1130 @ 2 1/4 lb \$36.72 Judith 1080 @ 4 1/4 lb \$3.20 Received balance \$74.92 weighing 10 cts Paid Fred Ford balance on colts / Kate Dan \$25.00 In PM Willie Dished in No 1 & old team and I plowed with Kate and Jess. May and I drove down town at night took to Russell's 5 lbs butter @ 22¢ 1.10 got groceries \$1.10 I took to Armstrongs and 7 dog eggs @ 16¢ 1.12 May got hat at Russell's night \$3.10 I paid Hamlin and ate in publ \$12.50 I got at Woods two collars 25cts.
