U.F.Y.P.O. held an interesting meeting in Community Hall when Mrs. Felfu put on some interesting moving pictures besides violin solo by Florence Carr, club papers reading by Edna Jarvis, piano duet by Mrs. & Miss Wills & Helen in making it one of our best meetings.

Wednesday 17

Roscoe and I drove truck up to Bily's at night to get some milk. Stayed for a while and "Katie" showed us "Billie's" wedding garments and played the wedding music for us.
