

Saturday, January 31

1875-

- Mar 30th. Had tea at Mr Buffets and spent the evening at Mr Scotts.
- 25th. A nice spring rain, cleaned up seed oats.
- 26 - Drew a load of manure and made the hot bed, helped R. Mc Donald to saw wood in the afternoon.
- 27 - R. Lowe brought his engine & saw and we sawed our pile of wood.
- 31st. Drew a load of saw dust from R. Franklins and went to St George in the afternoon for seed corn, 3 bus Wisconsin No. 7 & 3 bus Seaming, also corrugated roofing for 70¢ per sq. yd. from Holt.
- Apr 1st Drew a load of turneps to Paris 45 bus @ 25¢ per bus.
- .. Went to Missionary Study Class at St George in the evening.
- 2nd Helped Bert to move his rigs etc. over to R. Franklins sale.
- 4th Easter Sunday was a beautiful day, very clear and warm.
- 5 - Went to Wilson Franklins sale, there was a good crop.
- .. 7 - Exchanged a load of corn stalks and a few turneps with Fred Griers for a load of straw for bedding, went to McCombs in the evening for some Maple Syrup.
- 7 Sowed seeds in the hot bed, 4 rows tomato seed, 1 of cabbage, 2 of Asters (5 colors) also cosmos, lettuce & radish.
- .. 8 - Clipped Major in the forenoon with R. Franklins chippers. Drove to Brantford in the afternoon, going to Echo Place to see Mary Bell and her little girl, "Mary Ruth", and came home by Paris road and spent the evening at "Shanfi".
- 9 - Went to R. Robertsons to get what seed oats he could spare of the P. A. C. No 22 (about 20 bus). Also got 5 gallons of Lime Sulphur Mixture from R. Atkin. Went to Dr Barras in the afternoon.
