Mon Jul 23 a heavy fog this morning, clear part of the day and very hot, thunder clouds in evening no rain here, we were cutting wheat part of the day.

Tue Jul 24 clear and hot part of the day, we finished cutting and binding our wheat.

Wed Jul 25 some clouds no rain, hot I cradled around the barley field in the fore noon after noon Henry Snarey was cutting and binding the barley with their binder Henry Snarey and wife is here from Chicago on a visit.

Thu Jul 26 cloudy and warm some light showers finished cutting and binding our barley.

Charley's Father died last night.

Fri Jul 27 a heavy fog in the morning, clear and hot in the after noon, was hoeing carrots fore part of the day, latter part attended the funeral of Charley's Father

Sat Jul 28 clear part of the day and pleasant, we drew in a stack of wheat to day the first Sun Jul 29 clear and very hot in the middle of the day, not to Church to day.

Mon Jul 30 clear and hot, we were drawing our barley, Duncan Bolton and his wife and Jane Cragg here to day Henry Snarey and wife started for home this after noon.

Tue Jul 31 cloudy part of the day a light shower this evening, a hot day, we finished drawing the wheat and barley all but the raking.

Wed Aug 1 clear and pleasant, Walter raked the barley stubble this fore noon, after noon he and Rose went to Thamesville, I was hoeing.

Thu Aug 2 cloudy most of the day sprinkled rain not much came, cradled around the oats in the morning hoeing most of the day.
