We planted 4 maple trees (got from Alpanga by father 80cts) along A.S.R. fence No 3 replacing 4 dead ones. then put broken wire around part again East corner of fence and South corner. May down in a lot in buggy went to Jemlin to see remain of Mr. Jemlin: got better money Mrs Wilson 52cts. I went to Jemlin funeral P.M. got pain Killer Day: 25cts. Willie plowed some No 2 P.M.
