3. The ice was too soft yesterday, for to play and they played today. Home won 6 to 2 2 qts of milk. Rain in forenoon, about noon it began to storm, and by 4 P.M. was wild wild, and now 8 P.M. very high wind. but no snow
4. Quite cold today quite a change from yesterday. Boys drew all the green wood Huntington beat Alexandria today sent a letter to Bridie
5. Fine day. Boys drew some dry wood, 2 qts milk Martintown Hockey, played our team, Home team won 10 to 0
6. Fine day, Mr. Mc Gillivray, nephew of G. H. was in church. He is on his way to the North West, he left Calcutta, India, in December. He & wife took tea with us John Robertson & Flora Ann Christie called
7. Fair in early morning then began to rain rained all day. 70 2 qts milk
8. Boys drawing wood. Got the pictures Jimmie is pasted 5.40. frame 9.15. Randys common, from 3.15 - total 11.85. A letter from Mission. Sold 2 1/2 doz eggs, got 1 lb 3 tea 25. 1/2 lb B. 30. The eggs were 23 pr doz
9. Boys finished drawing the wood. I am making a small washing every day.
10. Frost and sunshine. Jimmie went to Coon well. Pa sent to D. B. for \$100. I was at the Manse, for a couple of hours from 12 to 1. 8

11. Cold & bright. Jimmie got home at 10.20 M 70 2 qts milk Lizzie B. was in for a while
12. Fine day Jimmie went to Alexandria Mrs. Surtino paid of rent \$1.50
13. Fine day. Our Minister at Toronto, Rev. Kenneth preached, a good sermon at 2.30 no prayer meeting
14. Fine day I am going to the Branch, 2 qts milk
15. Got home from Branch about 4 P.M. Jimmie went up with me on Monday, and left me, he was going to Lunenburg to play hockey. Williams won, 2 games, all that was played. This has been a blustering day, snowing all afternoon
16. Wednesday fine and bright. The boys drew two loads of straw yesterday from the Coon. This looks like sugar weather
Mr. Bush got the Key of Post Office for a man who works for him. 70 2 qts milk
17. St. Patrick. Very fine Boys drew two loads of straw Tenant came to post office. A letter from Mary Mc Leman written on 8th March
18. I have a pretty bad cough, and feel like fish Jimmie sold 3 doz eggs, 87 cts. 70 1 gall milk we went to Coonwell to play hockey. Williams and Marville, on Cornwall rink
19. Very fine and bright in forenoon, turned soft and snowing in afternoon, 70 1 gall lard oil 5 lbs sugar on egg account. I was very sick last night. Had a letter from Marion today. Flora Hughie, died last night Mrs. Sheriff Mc Intyre died yesterday
20. Fine day. I was not in church. I was too well
21. Mrs. Sheriff Mc Intyre buried today in the Mc Intyre plot. Flora B. Mc Leman buried here today I had a number of calls. William Mc Leman Mrs. A. G. May, Mimmie, Burn, Kate Don, Roy
