Post-Operative Suggestions.

1. Stop anesthesia as soon as the operation is over, as it has been demonstrated that the greater the amount of anesthetic given, the greater the likelihood of kidney disturbances, and the greater the shock. This caution refers to the fact that sometimes the anesthesia is considerably continued for a prolonged and tedious dressing.

2. As the patient immediately after operation rapidly loses heat he should be uncovered as little as possible during the lressing, and warm blankets should be placed about him, lest severe chilling occur and be one of the causes of shock.—
