Mostly fine sunny warm. Mr Barbour had Puck all day. We plowed in small field below orchard. Willie helped Bella garden etc. At noon Mr Eccleston came up on wheel wanting me to get to Wilsons office as he wanted to pay off mortgage held by J. Hoy estate. I drove down to Wilsons T.C.R. was there we got the transaction done I got at Phillips baking soda 11 lbs brought up from M: Demotts 2 horse blankets to see if we would buy them. I scuffled 2 rounds of mangles after I came home. I took J.A. to lecture in J.H. by M: Lusk a returned 2 church chaplain of the soldier at the front and formerly of Guelph. He was returned to Canada as unfit for further military service being wounded. admittance 50¢
