of Oats Magriet went down 28th
Fine W Wind Began the Fence at the
end of the Lane Narcisse got a Hook
in one of his fingers had to cut it
out with the Razor very bad in
had to file the hook off cutting Brush
Gordon came had 2 lb of Tea 80 cents
Randolph came no fixing on
the Boat Bismarck came on
night Peter the Fishermen
came had Narcisse's new Boat
got a Postal card for Narcisse
to go down next week to the
Wedding 25th Rogation Sunday
F W Wind John Morris chartered
and Annie came have John
Morris 6 Bushels of Potatoes
to account of Digging the well
Gordon Bismarck and Randolph
went to Douquets Hevel
John Summers drew a Revolver
on Baby Nicholson Fisherman to Syrup
