- Thur. May 26. Fine but cold and windy. a slight frost this morning. Our men planted the Potatoes. I called to ask for Annie Teasdale.
- Fri. May 27. Fine day very cool. Mr Teasdale and the boys here in the evening. Aunt Mattie called at Mrs. Clarkes.

Mon Aug 1. Fine until afternoon a little shower, men all here hauling wheat. all day. Circ Holiday.

Tue Aug 2. Fine day a little warmer. Our men all at Willie's all day. I took a basket of peas to Mr Teasdale in the evening. The strike is called off.

Wed Aug 3. Fine and moderately warm. Cutting Oats. Uncle and Auntie took butter out in the evening.

Thurs Aug 4. A very heavy rain last evening and through the night. very wet. Auntie and Uncle went to Sutton and Orchard Beach. Frank and Clara Teasdale here in the evening. brought apples and got some peas. It turned cold in the evening.

Fri Aug 5. Dull and cold. men cutting Oats. all day but only one way. Aunt Nellie has a very sore arm.

Sat Aug 6. Fine and very cool. men cutting Oats.

Sun Aug 7. Fine bright day moderately warm. I went to Mr Keppers with Clara and Frank Teasdale then went to Sutheran Church in evening.

Mon Aug 8. Fine day, finished cutting about ten o'clock. Over at Willie's hauling Barley in the afternoon.



- Tue Aug 9. Fine morning then rained in afternoon the men at Willis in the morning. Uncle and Auntie took the butter out in afternoon. Sizzie came home for tea. heavy rain at night.

- Sun Oct 23. Fine but cold. Uncle, Auntie and I at Church. Willis all here for tea. for Duck.
- Mon Oct 24. Fine day. I started to dig the garden, I walked to Thornhill for a parcel.
- Tue Oct 25. Fine day. picked Apples two barrells and a few pails. raking leaves and digging. Miss Uffland here for tea.
- Wed Oct 26. Fine day. Auntie and Uncle at Mr Gibsons in the evening took chickens. I took leaves away. men hauling in Turnips. it rained heavily in the night.



- Thurs Oct 27. Fine but muddy. Uncle in Toronto.
- Fri Oct 28. A black cold, cold with squawks of snow the first of the season. Mr Chatterly killed. Aunt Mattie came home in the afternoon.
- Sat Oct 29. Fine but very cold. all frozen quite stiff. in the shade all day.
- Sun Oct 30. Fine but a cold wind all day. Uncle, Aunt Nellie and I at evening church.
- Mon Oct 31. Thanksgiving Day - a beautiful day. Auntie cleaned dining room and put up Coal Store. Mrs McKenzie called. Marjorie here for tea.
- Tue Nov 1. Fine and mild. Uncle Aunt Nellie and I at Mr Trasdales for tea. it rained through the night.
- Wed Nov 2. Fine and colder. Uncle away North.
- Thurs Nov 3. Fine and moderately cold. the men ploughing Aunties at W. C. meeting. Thomas Oster died.
- Fri Nov 4. Fine but very cold. a little too much frost to plough in the morning but alright at noon. Duck went to ploughing match at R. Hill.

- Sat Nov 12. Rather mild and dirty. Jennie and Mr. Speight <sup>Frank Seasdale & family</sup> here for tea. Uncle took them to the car. snowed heavily in the evening a couple inches.
- Sun Nov 13. Fine but cold and squawky. Uncle, Aunt Mattie and I at church.
- Mon Nov 14. Fine day. Our men over at Willie's ploughing in the afternoon. roads very muddy. I called at Mr Seasdale's.



Tue Nov 15. Fine day men at Willis. Aunties and I at home washed and churned.

Wed Nov 16. Fine day, still muddy, men at Willis. Aunt Nellie at flower show and at Mrs. Spinghts.

Thurs Nov 17. Fine day. Mr and Mrs Teasdale here for tea their farewell visit.

Fri Nov 18. Fine but dull. Mick went home, and Uncle brought mother out for the spend the day.

Sat Nov 19. Fine and moderately cold. The roads a little drier.

Sun Nov 20. Fine but dull. Willie and the boys here for a while in the afternoon. I went to see Clara Teasdale for a while. Uncle, Aunt Nellie and I at evening Church.

Mon Nov 21. Fine untill evening it came a little shower. Aunt Nellie in Toronto.

Tue Nov 22. Fine bright day. Aunt Mattie and I in Toronto. Mick came back again.

Wed Nov 23. Fine day. Uncle took a load to Woodbridge in the morning and then went to Toronto in the afternoon. it rained in the evening.

Thurs Nov 24. Fine day. the men cleaning up Barley.



- Fri Nov 25. It came a little shower then cleared. Mrs G. Clark died. the roads dirty. Auntie stayed over at Mrs C.
- Sat Nov 26. Fine day. Uncle at Woodbridge in the morning then went to Maple to Mr Morgans in the afternoon and at Mrs Clarkes in the evening.
- Sun Nov 27. Fine but cold east wind. We went to the funeral Uncle, Aunt Mattie and I at evening church.
- Mon Nov 28. East wind with sleet turning to snow in the afternoon. We washed and churned. Uncle at Willis helping to kill a pig.
- Tue Nov 29. Mild but snowing a little. Cutters out. I went to Willis in the morning. Willis here and helped to carry apples into cellar. Uncle brought the Calves up and put them in.
- Wed Nov 30. Mild and snowing a little we went down to Mr Browns in the sleigh. Uncle and Auntie took butter out in the cutters but very poor sleighing.
- Thur Dec 1. Fine and turning colder. Aunt Mattie went to Mr Derlins <sup>thrashing</sup> Auntie Lizzis. Aunt Nellie went to W.A. Uncle took me out and brought her home. I was at the Euchre Club and remained all night. freezing hard tonight.
- Fri Dec 2. Cold. I came home early. Uncle made up the Cistern. today. Mr Granger thrashing.
