- Sat Nov 24. Fine day. Aunt Nellie took pigeons to Aunt Lizzie - Mother and the girls at the Artists. I went to Mr Bradfords for tea.
- Sun Nov 25. Dull day a little muddy. - Uncle and Aunt Mattie at morning Church. Annie and I at Fisherville - Mother and the girls here all day. we went to League in the evening.
- Mon Nov 26. Raining a little. Willie here for dinner, roads very bad.
- Tue Nov 27. Fine but dull and windy. Uncle Thrashing at ^{at home} Phillips
- Wed Nov 28. Mick here for the thrashing - fine day. Uncle and I at Mr Johnsons to get Frank to help with butchering. turning very cold.
- Thur Nov 29. All hard frozen and clean, finished thrashing at Mr Phillips in the afternoon. Aunt Mattie and I in Tooski had a lovely day, roads very rough.
