- Wed Nov 21. Rained all day. Uncle took Mick home.
- Thurs Nov 22. Dull and squawly, I went over to Mother's, Lizzie came back with me.
- Fri Nov 23. Fine day moderately warm, Mr Martins thrashing. Uncle shot pigeons for Mother.
- Sat Nov 24. Fine day. Aunt Nellie took pigeons to Aunt Lizzie - Mother and the girls at the Dentists. I went to Mr Hasdals for tea.
- Sun Nov 25. Dull day a little muddy. - Uncle and Aunt Mattie at Morning Church, Annie and I at Fisherville - Mother and the girls here all day, we went to League in the evening.
- Mon Nov 26. Raining a little. Willie here for dinner, roads very bad, ^{at noon.}
- Tue Nov 27. Fine but dull and windy. Uncle thrashing at Phillips
- Wed Nov 28. Mick here for the thrashing - fine day. Uncle and I at Mr Johnsons to get Frank to help with butchering, turning very cold.
- Thurs Nov 29. All hard frozen and clean, finished thrashing at Mr Phillips in the afternoon. Aunt Mattie and I in Forest had a lovely day, roads very rough.
