- Sat Dec 10. Fine until afternoon a little squawly. Uncle and Auntie at Thomas Poles. Aunt Nellie called at Mrs Clarkes. the cutter out but poor Sighting.

- Sun Dec 11. Fine but very cold. Uncle and Aunt Nellie at  
Church. I called at Mr Debus in the afternoon.  
Uncle and I at Willis in the evening.
- Mon Dec 12. A little snow then clearing. We washed and  
churned. Uncle getting ready for butchering.
- Tue Dec 13. Fine and a little milder. but frosty at first.  
We butchered had a beautiful day got through  
about seven o'clock and all cleaned up outside.
- Wed Dec 14. Fine and mild. We made pie 17 in all. cleaned  
up and Aunt Nellie and Uncle took butter to  
Thornhill. Mr and Miss Wilcox and Miss  
Howard called collecting for Organists.
- Thu Dec 15. A very stormy day. Snowing and then got up a fierce  
wind. Willis butchering pretty cold. Mr and Mrs  
John Baldwin here for tea. so we came home a  
little early but nearly all done. Cutters all out.
- Fri Dec 16. Fine and very cold down to five below zero but in  
some places ten below. Uncle and Aunt Nellie  
at Thomas Poles for tea. Sight Coal feeders.
- Sat Dec 17. Fine and much milder. Aunt Mattie took Aunt  
Jimmae boy to the station.
- Sun Dec 18. Mild in the morning. Uncle, Aunt Mattie  
and I at evening Church. Siggie walked out for tea.

- Mon Dec 19. Fine and mild. Uncle in Toronto. Aunt Mattie and I called on Mrs Frank Trasdale.
- Tue Dec 20. Fine day very cold. I went to Toronto. Uncle took me to the car. I called to see Aunt Siggie.

- Fri Jan 20. Fine and mild finished thrashing at ten o'clock and cut straw until noon. Came a little sleet in afternoon.
- Sat Jan 21. Fine day turned colder at noon. Uncle took a load of straw to Dr Campbell. I went to Pink and remained at Mother's over night. Aurora Band there.
- Sun Jan 22. Fine day moderately cold I came home with Uncle and Aunt Mattie from Church. Uncle, Aunt Mattie and I at Mrs Clarke's for tea.
