1919

- Mar 23<sup>rd</sup>. Clarence & Marie with Ada Busner & Miss Bell came out for tea.
- 25 - Took a load of potatoes to pass Station. Edith, Lane and I went to Jim Atkins in the evening to get 1/2 bu sweet clover seed.
- 26 - Sowed nearly a bu of sweet clover seed in wheat in 14 acre field.
- 27 - Went to Lowell Kitchens sale and bought two farms Colchester place.
- 28 - Mr Johnson helped to clean up seed grain in the afternoon.
- 29 - Shipped 2 lots of P.O.C. hns Vata @ \$1.50 per bu.
- 31 - F. Mc Donald came down in the evening bringing Durend and he and I went to an <sup>55</sup> Executive meeting in the Baptist Church. <sup>Sett the green 14 eggs</sup>
- Apr 1<sup>st</sup>. A very sandy day and rather a cold one too.
- 2<sup>nd</sup>. Uncle Andrew Stuart Rossetta Sharp came over for a visit.
- 3<sup>rd</sup>. Watered brush and burned it in the afternoon.
- 4<sup>th</sup>. Cleaned out the runner through the swamp, away from the Springs. Mr Hartley & Mr Johnson came over at night to help me kill a pig that had got its leg broken.  
Ralph Blueless came from Hamilton to stay over night.
- 5 - Went to Brantford in the afternoon to S.S. Executive M.
- 6 - Alvah Lee came out for S.S. and to spend the evening.
- 8 - Sowed seeds in the hot bed and some variety Tomatoes in the house.
- 9 - Transplanted some spruce trees along the lane. trimmed the grape vines.
- 10 - Grandpa & George Lee came over and took up the sap from the bush.
- 11 - <sup>Cal. Professor wedding Day</sup> Went to Social evening at Frank Ricks A. a fine crowd.
- 12 - Took fat cattle to the Glen baby beef mottle at 15 mos old <sup>159</sup>  
1 fat heifer <sup>1050</sup> 3 steers <sup>2900</sup> & 4 steers & heifers <sup>3320 lbs.</sup> <sup>55</sup>
