Sun 14 Missionary meeting. Arthur took Jim Marshall home then drove to church. Polly & Lilly brought Hattie home came over to church. quite stormy snow almost like rain. The youngsters went over to the other house in the afternoon.

Mon 15. Beautiful day sunshine all day but cold wind gets colder towards night, but showing very cold in the morning. north-west wind. Mrs Reesinger bought 2 lb butter for her customer. Arthur drewed 2 loads of rails with fack & the black coll. on the afternoon Will went to Mr Credes to cut feed. & Arthur & Paul drewed manure from their barn. Mrs Zimmerman went home. Margorie went to Drummondville had 2 1/2 lb butter ought to be 70 & she allowed @ 3-107 for eggs got brown sugar 25 black & white thread 10 bar soap 15, 2 lb salts, corn starch 10, got 5-0 lb bran 60. paid \$1.00 for native herbs of the egg money took Jim <sup>due till</sup> out for 7<sup>th</sup> & me 65. lb tea 30. The rest on fish. Will's <sup>at early night</sup> butter had

Tue 16 Dr Glasgow funeral. we had to get up early to get Paul off on the team to go to Welland the wind blew a gale & snowed. sometimes it came in fits & starts one hour got so black you could not see. an awful big funeral. Hattie went by Chippawa & Arthur & Hattie went by <sup>traces</sup> Hattie stayed all night & started for Buffalo next day. I cleaned the stable & bedded them. Will, Margorie & Gordon watered the cows & horses.

Wed 17. Doctor Burger arrived. colder than yesterday & wind from the west - instead of south west - at yesterday I got up twenty minutes in 4. & made the fire went back on bed until 7. then the house was warm. I got breakfast & Margorie went out & fed them we had breakfast <sup>on the porch</sup> & the children watered the things, Margorie milked & I separated the milk & washed the dishes & separated the youngsters took their dinner. Paul got home he stayed in Welland all night - at the transition house, cold night.

Thur 18. I churned & worked the butter, Margorie working at the fold on her skirt. Will went down to Chippawa after Hattie nice sunshine & cold wind. he took 1 doz eggs @ 20<sup>th</sup> for us & got 1 dozen of fish. Paul kept the smoke house going all day. Friday 19. dull, & stormy snowing & raining at times Margorie baked a big bakony, Kate Reesinger here all the afternoon & Will came on before her. & Arthur came on. Paul making the door at the stable. cow stable in two parts.

Sat 20 wind north. I was sick with a cold. Margorie swept & cleaned the kitchen swept the front room. I washed her underwear & Marguerite washed her underwear. Hattie went to Sharps Arthur took her to the trace. Hattie cold wind but showing sun.

Sun 21 wind north east. Hattie dinner we had the salmon trout for dinner. Arthur took Hattie & Marguerite to the brick church cold but showing. bright sunshine. Will went over to see ferry Brown. Ferry had an abtess opened. Marguerite went on from church & stayed all night. I had breakfast next morning.

Mon 22. beautiful sunshine but cold wind Hattie over in the evening with her Harp. Ben Saylor & Woodhead at Will's Hattie up to Ben Heimers in the afternoon. yesterday they called on John Lundy. showing but cold.

Tue 23. John Marshall at the school in the forenoon. I made ginger cookies. I cleaned the lower part of the corner cupboard.
