money. PM I finished putting bolts in key slide
also made new pin for sheep with bands. Willi sharpened
circular saw. A sheep had 2 bands to-day. Martha
Magwood brought Mrs Rows (25 ds) for Lindale's present
up PM. Mary called on Mrs Scheris PM they are
intending to move to Port Stanley to-morrow.

Frosty cloudy and sunny thawing a very little
in sunshine. ^{Willi} went to Scheris in morning to help move
him to station on route to Port Stanley it was about noon before
they got loaded. Over day was Bawley & Jim Whittow also took loads.
I took 4 bags grain to seed farm Lucy in cutter then took rest down
in Scheris sledge and his horse. Mrs Scheris got dinner here.
Willi and I drove down to seed farm PM. got 1st on barley 1st
on Joanette's oats 2nd on wheat. I got bread 70s 16 ds paid 10 ds to
Gibson for mending both of cutlery & hammers. I got cheque from A Armstrong
for \$8.00 my money 2 from J Beattie Lambie Interest 49.50 Obedance
Int 124.50 Mary got milk money from Rows 16.00 I drove down 200 00.
