Willi went to Schairis in morning to help move him to station en route to Port Stanley it was about noon before they got loaded over day was busy & Mrs. Whitan also took loads. I took a bag grain to seed farm Lucy in cutter then took rest down in Schairis sleigh and his horse. Mrs. Schairis got dinner here.

Willi and I drove down to seed farm PM. got 1st on barley, 1st on foxtail oats 2nd on wheat. I got bread 70cts paid 10cts to Gibbons for mending bolt of cuttermill effector. I got change from Armstrong for \$8.00 large money & from J. Beatty Landlord ^H 49.50 Orlando's but \$124.50 May got milk money from Rivers 16.00 I drove down 2.00 00.
