Relief of Pain in Acute Otitis Media.

The following treatment has given excellent results in the relief of pain arising from congestion of the middle ear occurring in the course of acute otitis media. A solution of magnesium sulphate, three drams, in one ounce each of distilled water and glycerin is warmed and poured into the external auditory canal and retained there for ten or fifteen minutes. The relief in most cases is immediate, and in not a few cases the inflammatory symptoms disappear without further treatment.—Dr. J. D. Thompson; Med. Record.
