Sunday some snow this morning North West Wind some
high the calm Monro aground at the Light house
Mr Hills Light got aground last night one of the
old Man's son-in-law here this morning Battance Latour
from Valley Field got a Drink of Milk gave 5 cents
and a cent to John He gave him 4 Pkgs of Tobacco
of my own Raising a very fine man seemingly
the Spontan went up Tronella coming up with
a good Sow 2nd Working at the Shed a
very fine Day 22nd at the Shed covering it
Boarding the North End cut some
Musk hay to cover the top of the shed Randolph
cut 10 Cops Lots of Wild Geese flying West
23rd Sunday Birth Day 1868 10 years old Today Randolph
drew the Hay to put on top of the shed began
to Bank the West end of the House & Wind and
it Blows very hard tonight from the West
it Blew through the night Water
Rained and a Blowing Rain some
old Robert got Pepper killed 2 Bush
from the Boards on the West end of
the Banking of the house took
some hay from the Back
marsh stack got in the sheep
so we could catch the Bishes
or the Wild South Down I must
kill her as she is the Devil to
make the other sheep Bad
catch 4th Our Hugh's Birth Day
Fishing some around the shed Went
the distance covering the little Back shed of all
Let out the other sheep emptied the Big Vneg
Jar a Great many Boats going
up and down the Waterfall
East night Big B Low Frost
at dear morning

yesterday 2nd Drawing wood cut some in

quits 27th Sunday Fine Day Calm wind Rained
Raining some Gordon Camp from Hamilton
at all night as the wind is little high and
some) wind high turned fine Gordon crossed
and West Hugh Fulton buried to day
city to Gordon at the head of the Island
called the Big South Down sheep and
I was fat my Back took a very bad
rain sent a Peep down to the fishermen
of Simon & St Jude 29th Bankus

me with the yarn spinning 5 lb of Rope gave her
