mill No 7 next hardwood bush west of it. Willie  
took lbs pig and lbs home chop to mill  
P.M. also 103 lbs long wool @ 20 \$20.60 and 31 lbs  
fine @ 22 \$6.82 to Russell on aft. he got barley  
and pea chop at mill paid \$3.00 on it. Mr Rose  
paid us to-night for hay got May 19th \$4.45  
Mr Son milk 5 butter money Nellie 95.

a few drops rain. We rolled buckwheat to mill No 7  
then went over it with weeder plowed nearly rest of rope  
land. thinned mangels. Willie went down for chop

on aft flour 3.35 lemons 10. Mother up in evening.  
Peter Clark had Lucy to-day.
