- 20. Rev. K. went to visit today we got coal oil 13 paper 1 cts Yesterday and today were very fine
- 22. Saturday Mirda came home yesterday, Jimmie went to Montreal this morning, will not be home until Monday, got 4 cts of pepper, and 8 cts of barley Hart moved most of his goods and family away from our farm. It will freeze pretty hard tonight - m Kenzie had another sale today
