planning about new kitchen. In P.M. we put  
in 6 hrs road work on Gordon Street. stopped by  
rain. I went around in evening telling  
people about road work went over to Joe  
Moffatt's Matteson Hamlet etc about kitchen.  
Received from Mrs W. V. Keith's Salt for butter 275
- 22 Saturday  
Fine sunny day very warm. I put in  
12 hrs road work in G.S. in A.M. with carpenter  
Willie thinned mangels. In P.M. I helped  
Joe Skeels & son to stony & vines in  
fence in their barn field. Willie harrowed No  
7 stump field again. Willie down town at  
night got watch \$1.00 ice cream 10 father  
up in P.M. I drove him down in evening  
got at Armstrong's in eve. Ten about 23.50  
brought up bag.
- 23 Sunday  
Fine sunny warm in A.M. rained in P.M.  
thunder and lightning. Mr. W. C. Vicar preached  
in A.M. from a sermon about  
little children and Joe Connie preached in evening  
from Matt 21:28 about working ch toll 25
- 24 Monday  
Very warm day rained a little in evening  
Willie sowed buckwheat and millet in No 7  
stump field to-day got colts buckwheat from Dallas 6000
