- 9 We drewed logs to day it was a fine winter day I think I can finish in a nother day if it is fine Budy scrubed and scoured things up to day till they shine like a negro's heel
- 10/11 I helped wash and went to see Dadys he is no better it was a fine day the best winter wether I ever saw I think
- 11/12 I drewed some logs it snowed this afternoon and is snowing yet
- 12/9 We went up to dadys Smuders and back to dadys Tuffs and home again it was a fine day
- 14 I drewed one load of logs and filed the saw it snowed all day

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- 15 I drewed logs in the morning and went to Kingsville this afternoon the slaying is fine I never seen better
- 16 We shelled some corn and cut some wood and did choers it is a lot colder to night I think the lain will be fool in the morning ~~for~~ for the snow is flying high
- 16 I sold two calves for \$19.00 it was a cold day I maid a platform for the stock and filed my saw so good night I want to go to bed
- 18 I did the choers and sit by the fire it was a cold morning but it rained this evening we went up to Dadys he is looking better I think
- 20 it rained all day and is raining yet I took it easy and watched it rain the slaying is brought gon in spots
