11 A & J Plowed A M opposite Billy
I Plowed P.M. A Plowed at Ben's
P.M. & Ben's Man helped truck at
David's Reason's for us Henry helped
truck at Peter Reason's all day
I went to Cedar Grove P.M.
W. very fine but Cloudy

12 Henry got Mares Perry & Minnie shock
A mended Ben's I Chopped A.M. As Henry
Plowed P.M. I took Butter & Eggs to
Cedar Grove P.M. W. slow & steady
rain nearly all A.M. Cloudy & Clear
P.M. Thunder over the lake & raining over
bedtime

13 A helped Thomas at Seeding Henry
Plowed I Mary & Anne went to Markham
P.M. W. very fine & warm. I went to
Cedar Grove A.M. Flavis were here
peeling apples this evening

14 I cut some Corn for J. M. Ruc A & Henry
Plowed A.C. came down about 9.00 & I
began cutting our Corn with Chief &
Billy the Binder work very well, he
cut with the Mares Perry & Minnie
P.M. A helped to draw Corn with
Trucks at Thomas's to fill his Silo
P.M. Henry helped to load. Saml Russ
cut with his Engine they filled the Silo

in about 1/2 hour. President M. Kibby
died this morning at 2.15 A.M.
Henry fine & Clear. The Engine & Cutting
Done. Came here this evening I went
to Cedar Grove & brought home some
chops P.M.

Monday 15 we & some of young folks intend
to go to Meeting at Altona but
rain stopped us so I & Mary & Benjamin
went to Por. No they were not at home
then went to Por. No they were not at home
so we went to Flavis to dinner. A
Mary Adeline Mary & Anne went to
D.D. I went to H. Conner's to dinner

rain when we got up Flavis & dinner
quite heavy about 8. There cleared up
rather heavy shower after dinner

16 Had Saml Russor to fill our Silo got
rather late start but got done at noon
we ran 5 Trucks I cut Ben's Corn with
Binder A.M. Then the whole crowd went
to Ben's & filled his Por. W. very fine & Clear
but a strong W. wind calm this evening

17 I Plowed Henry helped I Coe worth fill
Silo a draw some Basswood into yard
then went to Flavis about 10 A.M.
with team to put them on the Corn Binder
fill Flavis 2 Silos. Por. they got them
fill. they are about 1000 bushels
