Ellen & the girls cooked some of this day drew in two loads & cut part of the new peer 8 finished cutting the new peer that part that we placed in the fall is the best catch in timothy 9 drew in 3 loads got John Costlow to put in these I am so weak that I can do very little 10 went to granary with 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ bushel of wheat mill Besse went with me to see Danbury's mill very heavy rain to day Co-slow down some of the oats they are ready to cut 11 the Revd Mr Miller preached in the forenoon & Mr M. 12 I am not able to do any thing I am so weak a fine day Ellen & the girls raked up the oats that Costlow cut on Saturday Costlow came after he had done his days work with sheep drew in two loads that was all of them nothing done I am no better rained in this 13 Costlow cut the oats heavy rain & snow through the day very worse the time to showers to day I am draining little I did not get up
