Willie finished disking No 3 A rolled it and disked it again then harrowed some of it. I had potatoes etc in N. Orchard and after tea sowed 8 more rows turnips finishing to bush at bottom the 8th row from bush where I started being left hand canister was Durham turnips & come to bush

Saturday

Mostly fine sunny, not warm, M. Hill up all day driving team and being in N.O. I spread fertilizer bone meal on No 3.A. from lane fence about half way across & rolled it then drilled up the mangel land which we cultivated down again. We sowed the rest of our turnips down at bush mangel land and 59 drills I made in No 3.A. Willie cultivated 36 rows corn 2nd time. We paid M.H. 75
