- 18 Fine cold day, John Birdie and Agnes down I did not go to church sent my off 25^{cts} John has a new racoon coat 55^{cts}
- 19 Mild and thawing
- 20 Ann Hall 1/2 day 30.
- 21 Making plum pudding, 70 3 loaves 18
- 22 Made fruit cake mince meat
- 23 Ann Hall 1/2 day mupping 30, 70 2 loaves 12
- 24 Made a few pies
- 25 Christmas day, fine I was not in church, John Birdie & Raudy here to dinner
Sent my off to church 25, Got on Saturday through the mail from Marion 2 1/2 yds of

I got some things from Catons about 10 days ago with them a Thermometer, which I did not like it was graduated for the house, just 10 below free zind, Farquhar took it and gave me 40^{cts} what I paid for it, and Jimmie got one at Willis for 30^{cts} that goes down 50 below zero and up to 130, a much better one and only cost me 10^{cts} more
 - 27 Fine soft day, no sun Ann Hall 1/2 day 30

 - 28 Fine and mild until evening, when it turned stormy, Willie Dunlop came with Christmas Pic tural urned by Montreal Standard I had no change, Sabbath entertainment tonight
Paid W. Dunlop 30^{cts} for Standard pictures 60
Paid D. Mc Grimmon 4^{cts} for ground rent of village lot to St Andrews Church, Got 105^{cts} from Muddy, 70 2 loaves 12
 - 30 Begin to storm on evening of 28th and today, it is quite a blizzard, roads will be quite block ed up, Annual Meeting of St Andrews Congrega tion today Mercury down to 20
 - 31 Not so cold today, 70 4 loaves 24
