- 9 Fine day. 7/2 bread 25. Sugar white 25. In gar room The MacIntoshs were in and P. B MacLennan Duff Major paid 2 months rent 4.00
- 10 Bright cool day. MacLennan gave cheque on Merchants Bank for twenty dollars
- 11 Fine cool day. 7/2 1 gallon coal oil 535 to Jimmie for butter he got yesterday. And a balance of 13 cts on bread. 7/2 can varnish 25
- 12 Rain all night and rain all day ~~1 gallon coal oil~~ The pic nics which were to have been today have been postponed

- 13 Fine and cool today. 7/2 loaves 10. day Buns 10. Cheese 35. Butter 73
- 14 7/2 bread 20⁰⁰ Birdie J. P. and two girls down
- 15 I made the washing and I am pretty tired. Mrs Falkner & Mrs Rogers called at dusk. MacIntoshs called and took Marion. 7/2 bread 20⁰⁰ Mrs Ellis paid 1.00
- 16 Lawn social at J. Peter Frasers. Jimmie went Mrs Robertson called
- 17 Very hot weather Marion got home 10 P.M.
- 18 Jimmie cut the meadow
- 19 Boy put in two big loads from the home meadow. 7/2 sugar 1.00 Butter 65. Bread 20. molasses 25
- 20 Bot of a gypsy girl 4 yds of 6th insertion 20 Killed a black hen Tea dust 25. 1/2 B tea 20 a new kind of breakfast food wheats 25. 1 lb onions 5. Rain thunder & lightning
- 21 Fine day I was in church. 7/2 15 The Govins called after prayer meeting. The MacIntoshs called. did not see Man Tubby got badly ~~injured~~ out on the wire fence that is around the garden
- 22 Rain in forenoon. 7/2 loaves 10
- 23 Jimmie began to cut the hay. Has John Fraser Jimmie bought Murdy's horse George, and will use him at the hay harvest 7/2 butter 47⁰⁰ 2 loaves 10
- 24 Looks like rain. John Fraser at hay
- 25 Rain all forenoon high wind all afternoon 7/2 bread 15. Marion and I called at Robertsons last night Killed a black hen
- 26 2 loaves by McDonald boy 10. Far came in morning J. P. Birdie and Agnes here
