

Friday March 24, 1922

Mr. Keahy showed me a letter he got from the P.O. Inspector at London saying that he had not got instructions from the Department as to what they should do about the mail route; and told him to arrange with some one by the day after the 30th of March if he didn't hear from him before that date.

The day was fine but the roads are very bad; the clay rolls on the wheels in places.

Kent and John finished the route with the carts.

The day was fine but the roads were bad the clay on the 13th rolled on the wheels so that Dick had to stop and I poked the mud out
