Hernia in Infancy.

Hoguet advocates operation where the hernia cannot be perfectly held in place by a truss. For the treatment of umbilical hernias begin early by applying a small pad over the hernia. This can be held in place with adhesive plaster all round the body, renewing same every ten days. It is important there should be no interruption to the treatment, which generally has to be kept up from five to ten months. In children over two years this may be tried for a few months, and, if unsuccessful, operation.—Archives of Pediatrics.
