18	Sunday Cloudy not very frosty. Mr McVinn preached in A.M. from wherever shall confess me — him will I confess and wherever shall deny — him will I deny. and in evening from Isa 65:17 a sermon on evils of Gambling Ch. call 50		50
19	Monday Snowing and blowing all day stormy. We brought over load hay and took back load manure Frank Dodge here he and Willie drove to C Richards in P.M. to get plane. unsuccessful. Frank stayed all night. Mr Short in to see Jennie.
