father left gave him 2 sticks for axe handles
10th Fanning the Beans 3 1/2 got my 2 of them 1 1/2
about 2 Quarts Thrashing some Buckwheat 3 1/2 Bushels
thrashed he got 2 Bushels I got 1 1/2 Sunday 11th Mayhue
here to night 12th Fixing the east shed 13th Mayhue went off
gave Bully to him Andrew Summers here gave
him 3 Pieces of Pine 8 Dollars towards the note
8 Dollars & 60 cents in the note this 8 Dollars is to be taken
out of the 25 which leaves 21 Dollars & 60 cents i owe him
the note Wetyas brought the axe handles gave him
some Potatoes 14th The Salaberry not up to day seized
the running in to the Skenand Went Down to
Charlies for the cabbage Found his house
Burnt Down got 11 sels Last night down
at my Place 15th The Salaberry came up to day
George and Jim Hopkins here for the Potatoes and wife
got my pair of the potatoes Raining Fixing the West
end of the House 16th Raining all day 17th Let
out the Rams The Black sheep along with
one of them again Working at the shed water

18th James Miller here
Sunday Raining some Water high at 3 Maps 19th
Went to Mr Hairsers Bought 50 lb oatmeal
2 Bars of soap 1 lb shot on credit (Bar 1/3 oil 1/3
chimney Lamp 1/6 Matches 1/2 pens 1/1 sweets 1/1 paper
1/2 Returned the Jar treat 5 cents paid this Pat
stopping at Mr Hairsers Levy pike and Bruce
here all night got some shot from them they stole
my mits 20th Lashey here finding his ass all
the Rams out now 21st On this day of the Month
Donald Albin Master Departed 1846 Killed the
Bull no one helping me but Gordon 22nd cut
the meat and salted over 300 Weight about 18 lb
of clean Tallow 23rd Melted the Tallow put some on
on the Back of the house 24th Lashey here took
away his Bed Moccasins tops gave him
2 pieces of meat Found 2 head of Barrels in
the cord Wood Bay 25th St Catherine Day a fine
Day the Salaberry came out of Salmon River
hard Work to Break the ice 26th Fixed
a door on the hen house shot a salubreak w
to fish eels got 1 Wild Geese plenty put
piece above the door 27th Henry here for
Wood taking in about 4 coals of marsh hay
from the front Marsh about 5 from the
Back Marsh put some on the top
the Sheds kind of soft to day 28th very
Drawing Wood Raining Salaberry into Salmon
29th Raining 30th Plastering St Andrews Day
1st of December Cold finished the Plaster
2nd Sunday fine Day 3rd Putting Board up on the
front of the house scow light house moved
Henshaws steamer came up with his Barge
and another propeller took a Barge into land
