- 22 Very fine day. Had a good meeting at the Lodge last night; 10th and Lilly, Maggy Fallon were nominated. Miss M Gulleray, Linn Kitch James Finly were also nominated. Put of Jim 2 pair trousers, 40^{cts} each I went to see old Mrs McEeman, who leaves for Apple Hill tomorrow. Bit at Grahams 4 lbs beef 7-63, paid 56 on 8 lbs I got from Sandy McIntyre 80
- 23 Wednesday. Mr Elder conducted the prayer meeting. Rev Arpad has gone on a visit 1-19
- 24 Another fine day
- 25 Boys are preparing to go to Montreal tomorrow. I am trying to finish a pair of pants for Jimmie
- 26 The boys did not go. They got word last night that there would be no game. Murdy got suit of Jimmie went to Lancaster, and paid 7³³ 38 to Sandy for one. Far came home with Jimmie. It looked like rain all day, very mild
- 27 Rained today raw and cold. Rev. McKay, Summerstown preached a very fine sermon, and a fervent prayer.
- 28 Butchered our fat cow today, she weighed 535. when dressed we did not weigh the hide
- 29 I called the beef and made some presents
- 30 There was not many at prayer meeting. Daniel Scott led the meeting. May McDonnell led the singing
- 31 Nice day
