- 1 Sunday. I was not in church in the morning
was there in evening
- 2 Farguhar did not go to Lancaster until
this morning Auntie is very sick
- 3 Auntie had Dr. Mowet to see her today
- 4 Got 10 yds cloth by post man, Far bought
it from Carr of Wales, 82 1/2 cts per yd 8-25
1 pair over stockings for Marion 35 25 35
1 pair for Bird 50 cts
- 5 Far came today with his trunk
he went to Lancaster again
Bought 2 Lamp Chimneys 1 yd Lamp Wick 17 5
- 6 Turning mild. Began Rain's pants
- 7 Muddy & Ran drew 1 load of stony
Muddy went to Lancaster with sleep
for Far, and his two mattresses
one wire the other wool
- 8 Began to rain, Angel poured
about 10 P.M. I was at Auntie's
after prayer meeting
- 9 I finished Rain's pants. The Good
Templars have called a convention
which is held today. And there
will be an open meeting tonight.
10. There were none of us at the meeting
last night. I went to Auntie's. Bird
was examining literature papers
Ran, had not the ready. It was
very soft yesterday. To what care
rages on the roads again.
This is a fine bright day. Not
enough frost to check the
ripple of the little streams
I am going to begin the washing
10 & 1/2 M. or 22 O'Clock.
