I thinned mangels set masts work on road work etc. W got some sheep clipped to-day by Mr Sars P.M.

25 Tuesday
Very warm sunny day. Willie finished our road work to-day by hauling 4 loads broken stones or deep stones from Lime Hill. We made 4 loads a days work with team we hauled to sand hill S.M. Kee & J. Blake also hauled 4 loads each to-day W... Maynard one. D. Skank & Ficks with Mr Sars finished clipping sheep in A.M. paid him \$1.50 Willie took wool to Russells 114 lbs @ 25 cts trade also unsorted fluss 9 lbs. he paid 7 red Armstrongs aft \$7.00 got at Ann on aft Ginnelton for sheep dip 20 cts. I thinned mangels in A.M. spread gravel in S.D. P.M. Father up in evening brought photo of J.B. Paulin. Got from B. Behans for butter 30 milk 5

26 Wednesday
Thunder lightning rain and wind last night rain in morning & cloudy cleared off fine sunny P.M. got a lot cooler. windy. Willie hauled 3 loads manure from Duims to-day took him down some stream we spread manure on No 2 & 3 rd land I thinned mangels. Mr Lunn was in P.M. thinning mangels we got 9 rows done in P.M. Girls down town P.M. got at Russells collar 25 also good on aft 1932 meat Mills 47. sold butter 1.95 got from Mrs Skook for fencing last Saturday \$1.00. We got books from Norton on 15th History of the World \$2.50, Rep 2 Stamp 1 Willie rubbed Gombolth canthi balsam on Mands foot to night she has been lame long time.
