We went up at noon put in two 42 of the cattle at allens fifty that were out on road. Willie set engine at angle and cut some corn for cattle for what we didn't get into silo. Mary went down to stay at home all night. Gus and Andrew Schanis over for 38 lbs oats in evening paid us 25 cts for new milk to be got

Willie went down 71 town at night got at Woodlows 2 pair units 20, star Phillips 1 Edith Allan in at 11 o'clock got head of pipe wrench.
