 very dry there is no ground a sprinkle
 the Rev Mr Gordon preached on the school
 house in the forenoon & the Rev Mr Cornell
 in the Church in the afternoon
 9 dressed dung in front of the house for turnips
 10 plowed for turnips & buckwheat ground dry
 11 finished plowing & dragged it before sowing
 12 plowed six furrows & scraped a ditch across
 the piece sowed a large pailfull of buck
 wheat & a peck of Hungarian seed & sowed
 up for the turnips a fine shower this evening
 Ad & billes went to the old place for the sheep &
 a load of manure I watered & sowed the turn
 ip seed some bushes Ad billes & I MC English brought
 the sheep & a load of manure
